Can I drop my child off to class and then pop out to run errands?

FREQUANTLY ASKED QUESTIONS PRE JUNIOR & JUNIOR



Can my child attend an obligation free trial class first?

Yes, your child may attend any class for their age group. If deciding not to enrol, no payment is owed. Once enrolled, you will recieve an invoice for the term or remainder of the term if starting after the term has comenced.

Can I watch classes?

We have a small viewing window where you can see what's happening in the class, whilst waiting. We value giving children the opportunity to bond with their teacher and develop a sense of independence. This is best achieved without an audience or distractions, therefore we do not encourage parents to stand and watch for more than a moment at a time.

Can I drop my child off to class and then pick up at the end?

Absolutely! Whilst your child is in the classroom learning, they are safe and supervised. You're welcome to pop out for some 'me' time or to run an errand during class time. Just ensure you are back by the end of class to avoid distress to your child

Do students do a concert?

We assume all pre juniors would be participating in concerts and will be counting in when preparing costumes. If you do not wish to participate you must let us know by the end Term 2 to allow for exact costumes orders. Full concert details are in our handbook.

Can I attend a make up class?

Yes. Please contact us if your child is going to be away from class and we can organise a make up class that is suitable for them. We offer unlimited make up classes each term.

What do we need to bring to class?

Does my child do exams this year?

These are not compulsory but highly ecomended as an introduction to learning how to prepare & set goals and aim for an outcome. Teachers are present with students for the first 2 years of exams helping to calm the nerves.
