CLASS FEES

Tiny toes -\$13 per class

Preschool - \$16 per class

All fees are invoiced x weeks per term pluss an annual \$40 registration and personal insurance fee.



DANCE STYLES

A fun class including ballet, jazz and (tap for preschoolers) and the use of basic equipment.

These classes are excellent for coordination, balance, use of space, confidence, developing motor skills, musicality, creativity and broadening the attention span. These classes provides a vital stepping stone in your child's dance training.

FACILITIES

We have 3 fully equipped studios with sprung floors, barres and mirrors, air conditioning & heating.

UNIFORM

There is a dance uniform that can be purchased at the studio. (optional for tiny toes) Lilac Scoop neck leotard with attached skirt & matching crossover, Pink tights, Leather ballet shoes & tap shoes for Preschoolers. All items except new shoes are available for purchase at the studio.

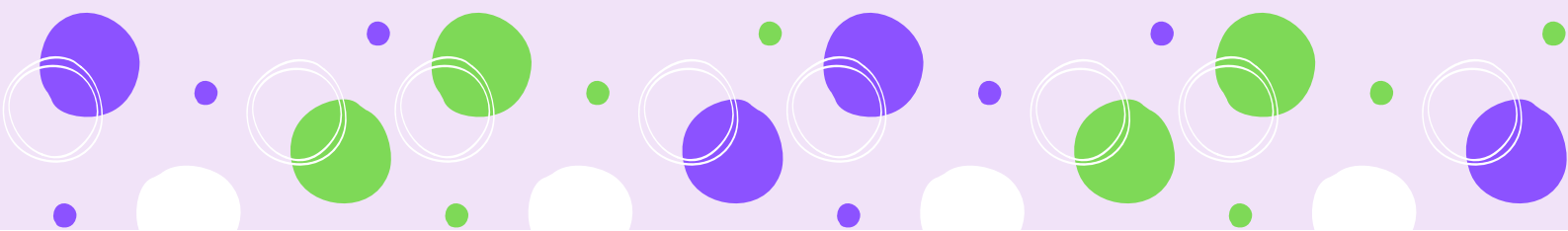
TERM DATES

TINY TOES-FREQUANTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can my child attend a trial class first?

Yes, your child may attend any class for their age group. If deciding not to enrol, no payment is owed. Once enrolled, you will receive an invoice for the term or remainder of the term if starting after the term has commenced.

Can I watch classes?

Yes, we encourage parents of Tiny Toes students to sit in the studio with them and help encourage involvement & listening if necessary. We do ask though to keep noise and distractions to a minimum to be fair to the class, particularly if you have another child with you.

Can my child attend a make up class?

Yes. Please contact us if your child is going to be away from class and we can organise a make up class for them.

What do we need to bring to class?

Please bring a water bottle (not glass). All other belongings should be kept with a parent or guardian.

Where do I park?

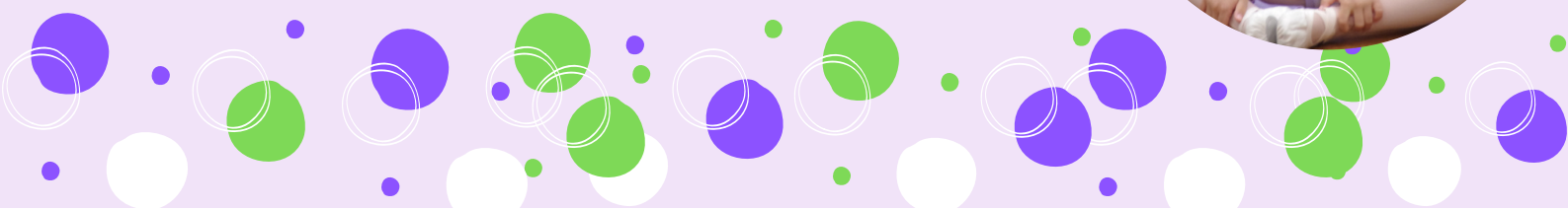
You can park in one of the 3 available spots in front of the studio or there is ample street parking along side the studio. We do ask that you do not park at the factory next door, or behind other cars in our carpark.

What happens if we miss a class?

If you let us know that your child is going to miss class prior or within 24hrs, we will register you for a make up class. Our make up classes do not have an expiry. We will try to offer make up class times that best suit the student first and that are suitable to your schedule.

Is there a concert for Tiny Toes?

Tiny Toes students will have their own opportunity to perform for family and friends in a casual concert at the studio at the end of the year.



PRESCHOOL- FREQUANTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can my child attend a trial class first?

Yes, your child may attend any class for their age group. If deciding not to enrol, no payment is owed. Once enrolled, you will receive an invoice for the term or remainder of the term if starting after the term has commenced.

Can I watch classes?

We do encourage parents to watch the first class to see what we cover in the class. Once students are settled though, we try to give the children the opportunity to bond with their teacher and develop a sense of independence. This is best achieved without an audience or distractions. We have a small viewing window where you can see what's happening in the studio, whilst waiting. However we do not encourage parents to stand and watch for more than a moment at a time.

Can I drop my child off to class and then pop out to run errands?

Absolutely! Whilst your child is in the classroom learning, they are safe and supervised. You're welcome to pop out for some 'me' time or to run an errand during class time, please just let your child know, so they aren't looking for you, and ensure you are back by the end of class to avoid distress to your child.

Do we need to commit to a concert and will my child need to wear make up?

We assume all preschoolers will participate, but appreciate that some preschoolers may not be ready. We do require a commitment to concert by the end of term 2, this allows us to order costumes which needs to be done very early. Yes they will be required to wear light stage make up to ensure their face is seen under the bright lights.

Can I attend a make up class?

Yes. Please contact us if your child is going to be away from class and we can organise a make up class for them.

What do we need to bring to class?

Please bring a water bottle (not glass) and a change of dance shoes. All other belongings should be kept with a parent or guardian or in the student lounge.

Where do I park?
